Juror Biography: Arthur Turner

Arthur Turner is a well-known teacher, lecturer, watercolor artist and a member of the Texas Watercolor Society. He has taught color and watercolor classes at Glassell School of Art for 37 years. He exhibits in many solo and group exhibits across the country including a solo show at the Museum of Fine Arts Houston in 2001, from which the Museum bought three pieces in his collection. He will be the first Texas artist to have a retrospective exhibit at The Jung Center in November 2007. This exhibition follows Turner's artistic, journey, beginning with figurative representation in his early work (1960's) , to his subsequent thirty year focus on nature—based abstractions, and, finally, his return to a more representational style. Turner is a native Houstonian and has exhibited at the Moody Gallery since the 1980's.
